01 Succession of unique tradition and indigenous varieties of Korean Ginseng

Over 1,500 years of history and tradition

- Korean Ginseng is a highly valuable agriculture heritage with 1,500 years of history and tradition
- Korean Ginseng was traded between Baekje (百濟) and Qin (秦) dynasty in 549

Successful conservation of the world's highest quality of indigenous varieties in Korean Ginseng

- For a long time, Geumsan ginseng has been called 'Geumjong', making it different from other regional ginseng varieties
- These are the most important sources of ensuring the sustainability of traditional ginseng cultivation

02 Succession of the nature-friendly and rotating agriculture system

Rotating agriculture system

- Sustainable use of farmland based on long-term cycle (10~15 years)
- Long-term period of fallow ground and crop rotation is considered as "agriculture of rotating" which is a unique tradition of land use by provision of nature

Preplanting field management

- One of the most important factors for ginseng cultivation is to recover a fertility of soil
- It is necessary to manage preplanting field for 2 years before cultivation to make soil conditions suitable for growing ginseng because fallow ground and crop rotation are not enough for recovering a fertility of soil

03 Tailored shading technique for wind directions and flows

The main reason why the artificial cultivation of ginseng was successful about 500 years ago

- Artificial facilities to make an growing environment similar to wild ginseng's environment

Ginseng farmland facing north or northeast

- It is to avoid direct sunlight and stay cool in summer as ginseng is a shade plant

GIAHS Certificate Award Ceremony and GIAHS Exhibition

1. Background

Certificate Award Ceremony and GIAHS Exhibition

Following the International GIAHS Forum in April 2018, where a certificate awards ceremony was organized, designation of new GIAHS sites has been actively promoted by the renewed GIAHS Scientific Advisory Group (SAG). As of March 2023, there are the following 24 new GIAHS sites in 12 countries which need official certificates: Brazil (1), China (4), Ecuador (2), Iran (2), Italy (2), Japan (2), Korea (2), Mexico (1), Morocco (2), Spain (3), Thailand (1) and Tunisia (2). Therefore, a new certificate award ceremony is expected by many new sites and countries. It was also recognized as effective to hold an event to exhibit the information on new GIAHS sites at the certificate ceremony.

2. The Objectives of this event:

- 1) To provide official GIAHS certificates to new GIAHS sites.
- 2) To review all newly designated GIAHS sites and exchange the issues, challenges and future plans for the conservation and development of the sites.
- 3) To raise the awareness of the GIAHS programme and the importance of conservation of biodiversity, traditional knowledge, ecological practices and cultures in FAO member countries.

Certificate Award Ceremony (Green Room) 22 May (please see Annex I)

- **Session I: Key Note Speech:** Ministers/Vice Ministers/Ambassadors from GIAHS countries representing regions will make key note speeches in person or with recorded videos.
- **Session II: Certificate Award Ceremony:** Representatives from new GIAHS sites will receive official GIAHS certificates from the FAO Director General on the podium of the FAO Green Room.
- **Session III: Presentation of New Sites:** New GIAHS sites will make presentations on their sites.
- **Interpretation:** Six FAO official languages will be provided.
- **Webcast:** The ceremony session will be webcasted all over the world.
- **Live Video Viewing:** Sheikh Zayed Centre open for public viewing.

GIAHS Exhibition Event (Atrium) 22-23 May (please see Annex I and II)

- FAO will set up tables or booths for the exhibition in the Atrium.
- New GIAHS sites delegates can show the information on their sites in the Atrium on 22-23 May.
